

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE PAGOSA PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., THE PAGOSA AREA WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT AND THE PAGOSA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT PERTAINING TO THE MANNER OF IDENTIFICATION OF THESE ENTITIES.

WHEREAS, the Pagosa Property Owners Association, Incorporated (a Colorado non-profit corporation), the Pagosa Area Water and Sanitation District and the Pagosa Fire Protection District each and all exist to provide services of varying nature and purposes for the public health and safety and common welfare of the residents, taxpayers and property owners of the several subdivisions known collectively as Pagosa, an unincorporated community entirely within Archuleta County, Colorado;

AND WHEREAS, these entities are wholly and entirely independent of, and not affiliated or associated in any manner or form with, any corporate or commercial enterprise;

AND WHEREAS, any commercial enterprise may at any time acquire the controlling interest in unconveyed lots and tracts or businesses located within the service area of the Pagosa Property Owners Association, Inc., the Pagosa Area Water and Sanitation District and the Pagosa Fire Protection District;

AND WHEREAS, the magnitude of such controlling interest by any such commercial enterprise must not be allowed to infringe upon or prejudice the integrity and identity of these entities, and that to do so causes a disservice to their respective constituencies, fosters confusion within the Community being jointly served, and ultimately and negatively effects the perception of these entities both within and without the Pagosa Community;

AND WHEREAS, the constituencies of these legal entities consists of several thousands of private individuals and numerous commercial enterprises of varying sizes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARDS OF DIRECTORS OF THE PAGOSA PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED, THE PAGOSA AREA WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT, AND THE PAGOSA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT:

Section 1. That the name of no commercial enterprise shall be appended to the legal names of the entities jointly passing this resolution.

Section 2. That it is the desire and demand of these legal entities that the media exercise due regard for accuracy in identifying them or using their names in any journalistic or advertisement context whatsoever.

Section 3. That the service area of these legal entities and the services they provide not be connected or linked with any one person or commercial enterprise.

Section 4. That the intentional misnomer of these entities jointly passing this resolution shall be considered an unauthorized infringement upon their respective rights, privileges and interests.
