

PLPOA RESOLUTION NO. 87-7  
SCREENS FOR TRASH RECEPTACLES

WHEREAS, the Association has undertaken enforcement of the nuisance prohibitions in the covenants and restrictions and;


WHEREAS, deed restriction on all subdivisions states that "Every outdoor receptacle for ashes, trash, rubbish or garbage shall be installed underground, screened or so placed and kept as not to be visible from any street, waterway or golfcourse within the subdivision at any time except during refuse collection" and;

WHEREAS, the "Waste Control" two wheel green plastic carts are the most common outdoor receptacles for individual residence trash disposal, and;


WHEREAS, these small carts are not unsightly.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the PLPOA resolves that the enforcement of this covenant be limited to gross abuses; e.g. damaged carts, uncovered carts, overturned carts, carts left on roadway shoulders, etc.
